## What is an Environment?

<u>Environment:</u> the surroundings or conditions in which a person, animal, or plant lives.

Some things in your environment are native and others are non-native.

Native: a species (animal, plant, etc.) that normally lives and thrives in a particular environment.

Non-natives: a person, plant or animal that is not native to a particular place. Sometimes Non-native animals/plants can be harmful to an environment we call those <a href="Invasive Species">Invasive Species</a>: (referring to animals/plants/diseases) that tend to spread rapidly and undesirably or harmfully.
